## Homeowner Assistance Available

**SURVEY DEADLINE: JULY 20, 2018**

This deadline does not apply to homeowners who have already submitted a survey or an application.

The Restore Louisiana Homeowner Assistance Program is dedicated to helping homeowners affected by the March and/or August 2016 floods repair and restore their damaged homes, and get reimbursed for work already completed.

- The first step is to complete a brief survey. Your survey responses will help us understand where you are in your recovery and what phase of the program you may qualify for.
- Qualifying homeowners will then be invited to complete the application in phases.
